

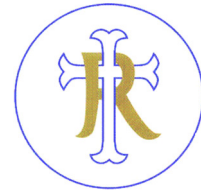
## Head Teacher's Message

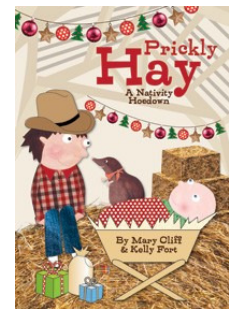
