Home Learning, Spelling and Reading

I will introduce our new spelling rule every Monday in school and we will continue to review this throughout the week. Spelling will be tested on a Friday. I will send home spelling homework every Friday (via dojo)- this will be the next spelling rule, not the one tested that day. It will be due back in on Wednesday (as this gives your child the weekend to complete it). You child does not need to bring this into school. They can send me a picture of it via email or post it on portfolio on dojo.

Please make sure your child continues to read at home. This will help to prepare them for secondary school.

PE

We will be doing PE on Thursday. On PE days, please send your child into school in PE kits. They do not need to bring their school uniform in. If the days change, I will inform you via dojo.

I know that for some children, coming back to school has been a challenge after being at home for so long. We will continue to work on growth mindsets in class and will be discussing our worries.

What should my child be bringing to school?

- Pencil case- this will stay in school and should fit in their tray (to make the tables easy to clean).
- Water bottle
- Lunch (if they are packed lunch)
