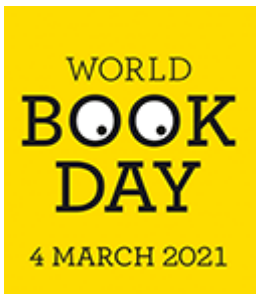

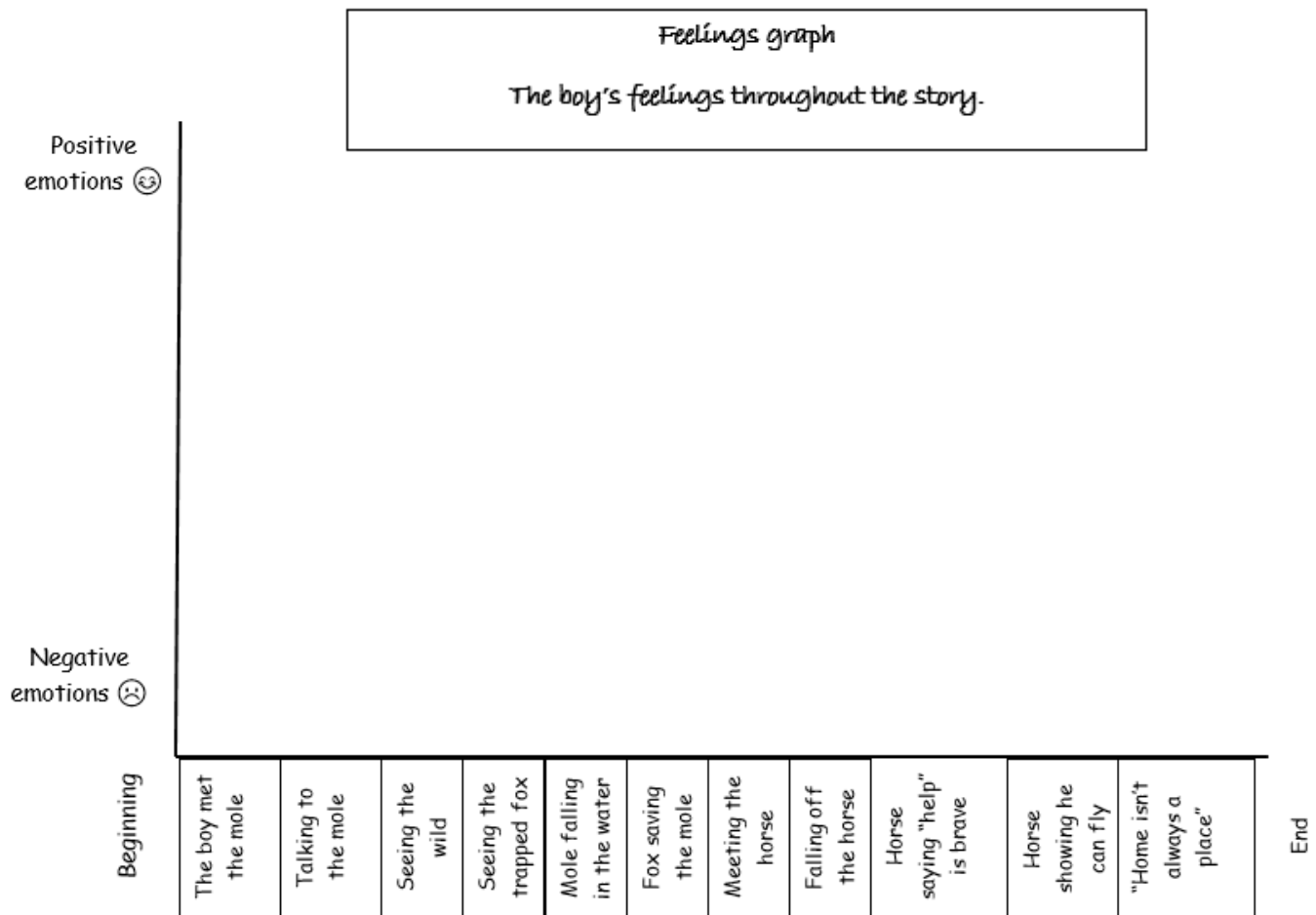
**English-** For our English session today, I would like you to finish listening to our book. Please listen to it the whole way through as then it will all come together ☺

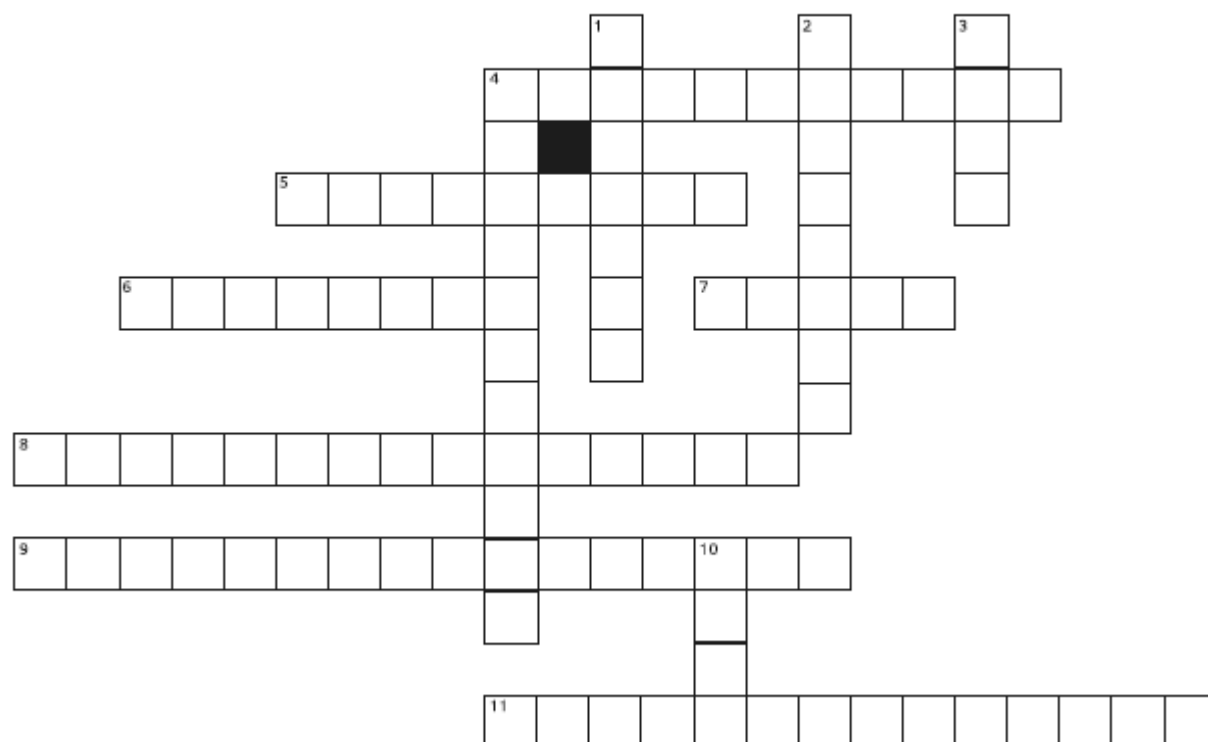

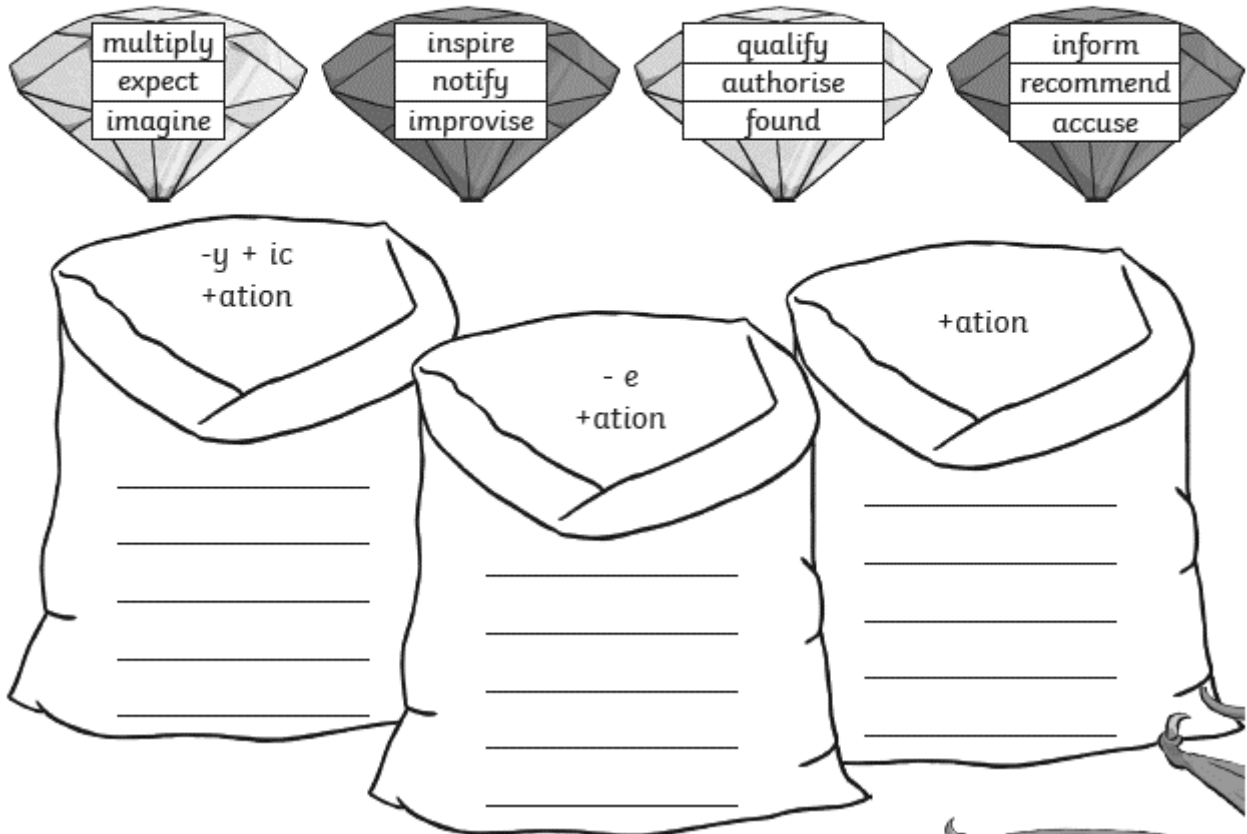
Session 3-GPS: we are learning our spelling rule again today. Can you remember what it is?
