Phonics	<p>Look at ar. Make the sound and read the words card and start.</p> <p>Play roll and read ar (attached on web page)</p>
Maths	<p>Warm up - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=JzuO6CfNWNE saying how many dots without counting.</p> <p>Look at the numbers 6 to 10, using our hands – talk about 5 and a bit for each number</p> <p>say a number can we show it on our hands. Show hands can we say the number.</p>
Small Group Time	<p>Doubles. You need a dice and some counters.</p> <p>Recap that a double is a number that is repeated. Practise rolling the dice and using counters to find the double. If you roll a 3 you get 3 counters and then another 3 to find double. Describe by saying double 3 is 6.</p>
Reading.	<p>Pose the question – what is an artist, do we know any artists. Explain an artists can use lots of different materials to make their work, today we are going to look at artists who make pictures. Put out a range of pictures both modern and traditional – choose a picture, what can they see, what do they like about it, what do they think it is – include the snail by Matisse and other pictures from the book as well as Mondrian.</p> <p>As a class look at the picture of the snail (the picture with the orange border, don't tell the children what it is) what can we see, what has the artist used, what do we think it is showing.</p> <p>You can try making your own snail picture using pieces of paper.</p>
Talk through stories	<p>Watch the story On the way home</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=URRAMHToe4s</p> <p>when finished talk about what happened and the problem Claire had.</p>
