Our Journey will begin with thinking about fairy tales and the characters in the stories and writing some of our own character descriptions.

We will be starting to find out about the different seasons.

We will then explore the art work of Andy Goldsworthy to inspire us and will create our own art work in his style using natural resources found in Rusthall.

We will carry out some field work in Rusthall to help find out about our local area.

We will explore how to use technology safely and learn how to display information in different ways.



We will explore Christianity and the question, 'What do Christians believe that God is like?'

Following our visit to the park we will design, make and evaluate new park equipment.

We will visit the Local park to find out about the play equipment and how it works.

We will continue to read more fairy tales and use these to write our own versions.

We will explore and start to learn the names of a variety of wild and garden plants.



We will write letters and recounts about what we have been learning.

During PE we will be learning some techniques for playing games and move onto some gym work focusing on using different body parts.

We will finish with some poetry linked to work on learning about our basic body parts and which senses they are linked to.

Doing

-Write a letter to a family member or friend and post it to them.
-Create maps of the local area or make believe worlds.
-Visit a different town/village and compare it to Rusthall

English and maths will consist of ongoing key skills to be completed little and often. The children will be assessed on the skills they have been learning for homework in class and there is no need to hand in written work for these elements.

Home learning will be given out roughly every three weeks. The hand-in date will always be on the home learning sheet.

Please remember that your child will need to bring their own water bottle this year



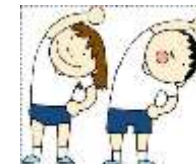
PE
