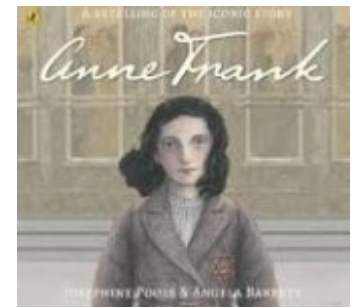


Enemies and Allies

School Uniform
